## **High Speed Craft Consultative Committee Consultation Paper**

### Carriage Requirement of ECDIS to Existing Registered High Speed Craft

#### **Purpose**

1. The purpose of this paper is to seek Members' view to the carriage requirement of ECDIS to existing registered high-speed craft (i.e. craft constructed before 1 July 2008) not later than 1 July 2010.

#### **Background**

2. On 17 March 2008, MD circulated the information paper HSCCC No. 1/2008 informing members on the implementation of carriage requirements of the Electronic Chart Display and Information System (ECDIS) to existing high-speed craft. Members were informed that MD would review the mandatory carriage requirement of ECDIS based on practical experience and feedback on the use of ECDIS.

# Measures to Implement the Carriage Requirement of ECDIS for Existing Registered HSC

- 3. Since then MD has jointly conducted two ECDIS demonstration with a HSC operator and one night service trial demonstration on board a high speed craft. Feedback from the operator and navigating officers gave positive recognition to the ECDIS that such system could enhance the safety of navigation on board the HSC.
- 4. In view of the above assessment MD intends to impose the carriage requirement that ECDIS should be installed on board all existing registered high-speed craft not later than 1 July 2010.
- 5. Members are requested to give their comments/views on the proposed new requirement.
