# Consolidated amendments to Code of Practice – Safety Standards for Class I, II, III and IV Vessels

#### **Purpose**

This paper informs members of the amendments to the Code of Practice – Safety Standards for Class I Vessels; Code of Practice – Safety Standards for Class II Vessels; Code of Practice – Safety Standards for Class IV Vessels (hereafter collectively referred to as "CoPs") to implement the proposals which were endorsed by this Committee in the 30th meeting held on 29 June 2021.

#### Background

- 2. The Marine Department submitted to this Committee in the 30th meeting of 29 June 2021 the following papers which were discussed and endorsed by members:

3. In addition, the determination of the validity of certificate and endorsement prescribed in the CoPs (chapter II) and the subsequent amendments will be promulgated by Marine Department Notice in future. Following the principle in the LVAC paper No.13/2021 which has proposed the removal of the relevant provision in the CoP for Class I vessels, the similar paragraph in CoPs for Class II and Class III vessels will be removed concurrently.

"classification society (CS)" means an organization approved under section 8 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance (Cap 369), which is one of the following

(d) DNV-GLAS;

"dynamically supported craft (DSC)", as defined in Ch. XI/1;

"high speed craft (HSC)", as defined in ch. XI/1;

"HSC Code" means the International Code of Safety for High Speed Craft adopted by the Maritime Safety Committee (MSC) of the IMO by resolution MSC 36(63), as may be amended by the MSC from time to time; , as defined in ch. XI/1;

4.2 Chapter XI will apply to new DSC and HSC. dynamically supported craft, and vessels which are designed and built to the requirements of rules and regulations applicable to high speed craft issued by a classification society as listed in Annex A of this Code.

(Note: The owner's Declaration shall be made at the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary date of the Certificate of Survey).

(Note: The owner's Declaration shall be made at the 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary date of the Certificate of Survey).
