Shipping Consultative Committee

Proposed new/amendments/repeal to the Merchant Shipping Safety Regulations, Cap.369

Purpose

1. The purpose of this paper is to seek members' views on the proposal to make new, amendments or to repeal the relevant local legislations for implementation of the updated convention requirements adopted by the International Maritime Organization (IMO).

Background

2. As the IMO convention requirements are amended from time to time, there is a need to update local legislations to give effect to the latest IMO requirements while the existing Hong Kong legislations were enacted before 2001.

Existing legislations and Proposed Legislative Amendments

3. The following subsidiary legislations under the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance, Cap.369 will be affected and their changes are listed in Annex with respect to SOLAS Convention:
