

**MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 170/2024**

(Marine Works)

**Submarine Pipeline Repair Works to the North of Sunshine Island**

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately three months, submarine pipeline repair works will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):

(A)	22° 16.319'N	114° 02.885'E
(B)	22° 16.258'N	114° 02.908'E
(C)	22° 16.240'N	114° 02.852'E
(D)	22° 16.300'N	114° 02.828'E

2. The works will be carried out by one dumb lighter. Two tugboats and one dry cargo vessel will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

3 A working area of approximately 50 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.

4. Silt curtains, extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established within the works area. The silt curtain is a large piece of netting used to contain mud and sediments. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.

5. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.

7. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the area.

8. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

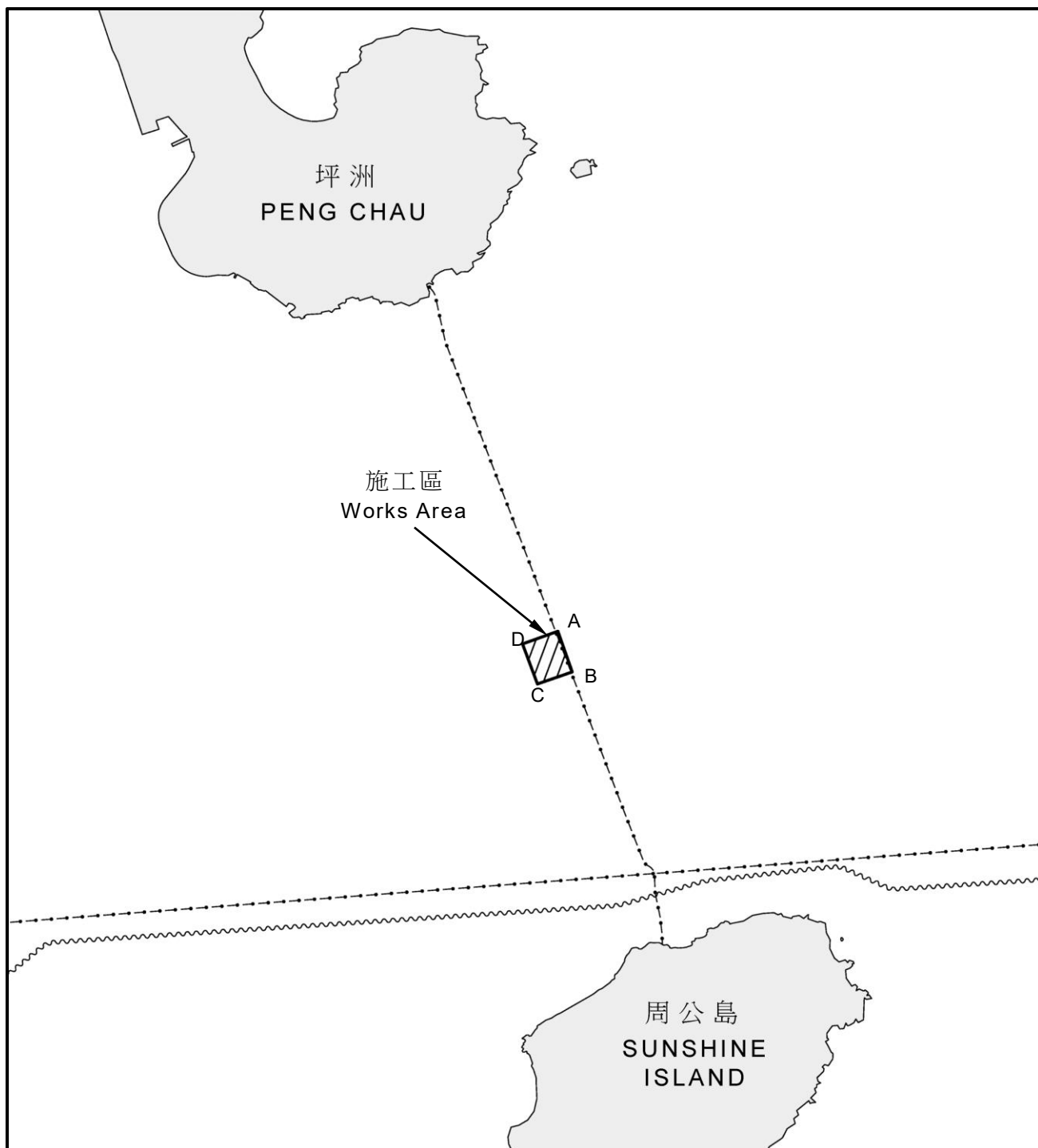
