(Marine Works)

Construction Works for Wave Wall at Lei Yue Mun

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately four months, construction works for wave wall at Lei Yue Mun will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 17.151'N	114° 14.515'E
(B)	22° 17.101'N	114° 14.506'E
(C)	22° 17.130'N	114° 14.428'E
(D)	22° 17.163'N	114° 14.434'E

- 2. The works will be carried out by one dumb lighter. One roro barge, one work boat and one tugboat will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
- 3. A working area of approximately 25 metres around the lighter will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the lighter.
- 4. A silt curtain which is a large piece of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed will be established within the works area. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtain.
- 5. The hours of work will be from 0700 to 1900 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
- 6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice. This Notice is an extension of Marine Department Notice No. 52/2024.


