

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 15/2025

(Marine Works)

Riser Pipes Repair Works at Sha Chau

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately five months, riser pipes repair works will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (D):

(A)	22° 21.233'N	113° 53.384'E
(B)	22° 21.186'N	113° 53.399'E
(C)	22° 21.172'N	113° 53.348'E
(D)	22° 21.219'N	113° 53.334'E

2. The works will be carried out by one work boat and one tugboat. Another tugboat will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.
3. A working area of approximately 30 metres around the working vessels will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the working vessels.
4. Silt curtains which are large pieces of netting to contain mud and sediments extending from the sea surface to the seabed, will be established within the works area. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the extent of the silt curtains.
5. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.
6. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the area.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

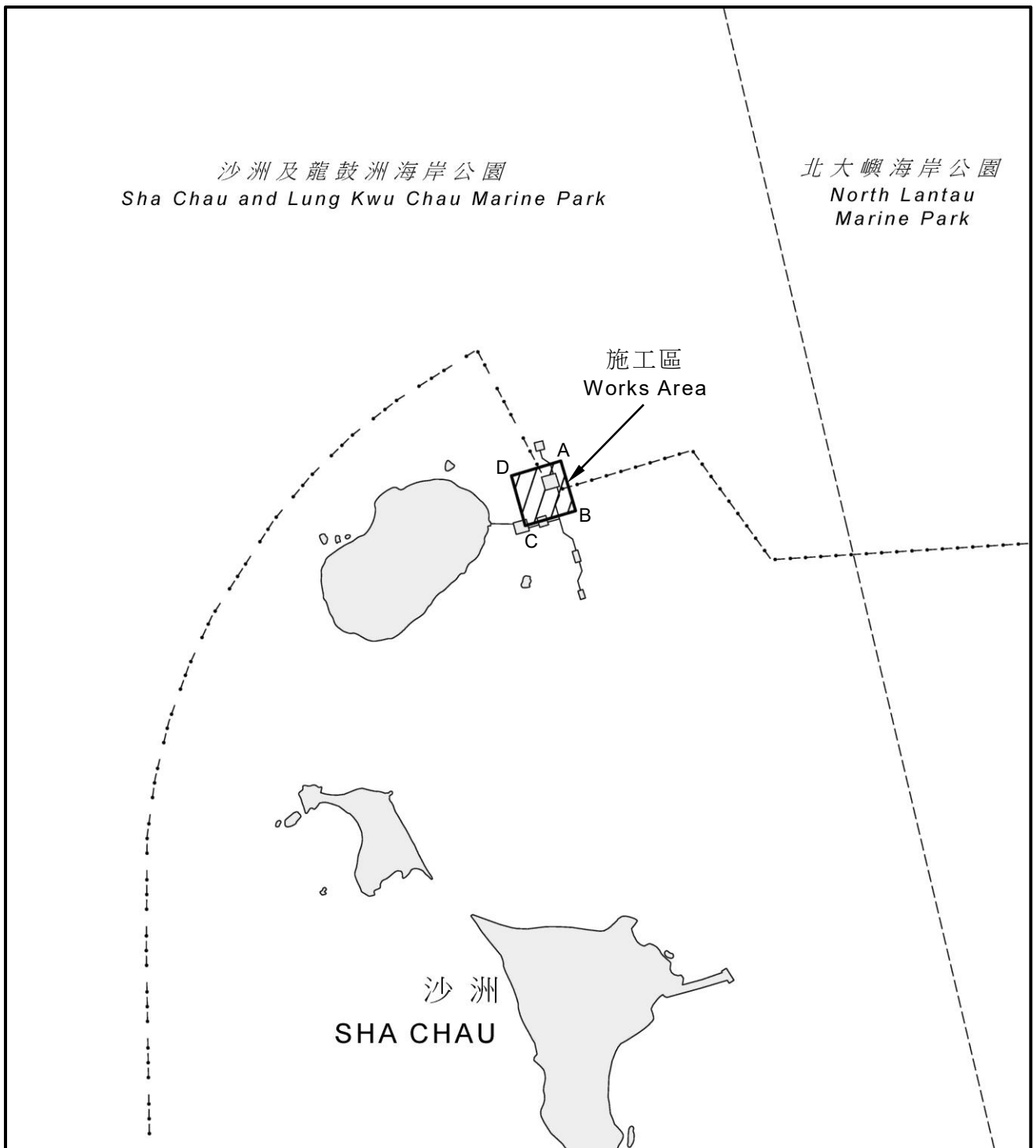
